The bleachers will be installed midweek. Strategies for the CTE application are being finalized. Trent Sommers reported that he attended a DSA pre-submittal meeting for the weight room and the locker room. He reported that there are no fire sprinkler or lateral upgrades required for the remodel. There will be some sidewalk upgrades required. Trent distributed a reworked floorplan for 8 classrooms for the Arbuckle Elementary project. The corridor conditioning was removed to cut down on square footage of the entire building. Discussion took place regarding window height and gates for safety. Lock systems and automatic blinds will be explored. As well as bulletproof glass. Overhang coverage was discussed to ensure there will be plenty of coverage during rainstorms so the water does not get into classroom doors.
